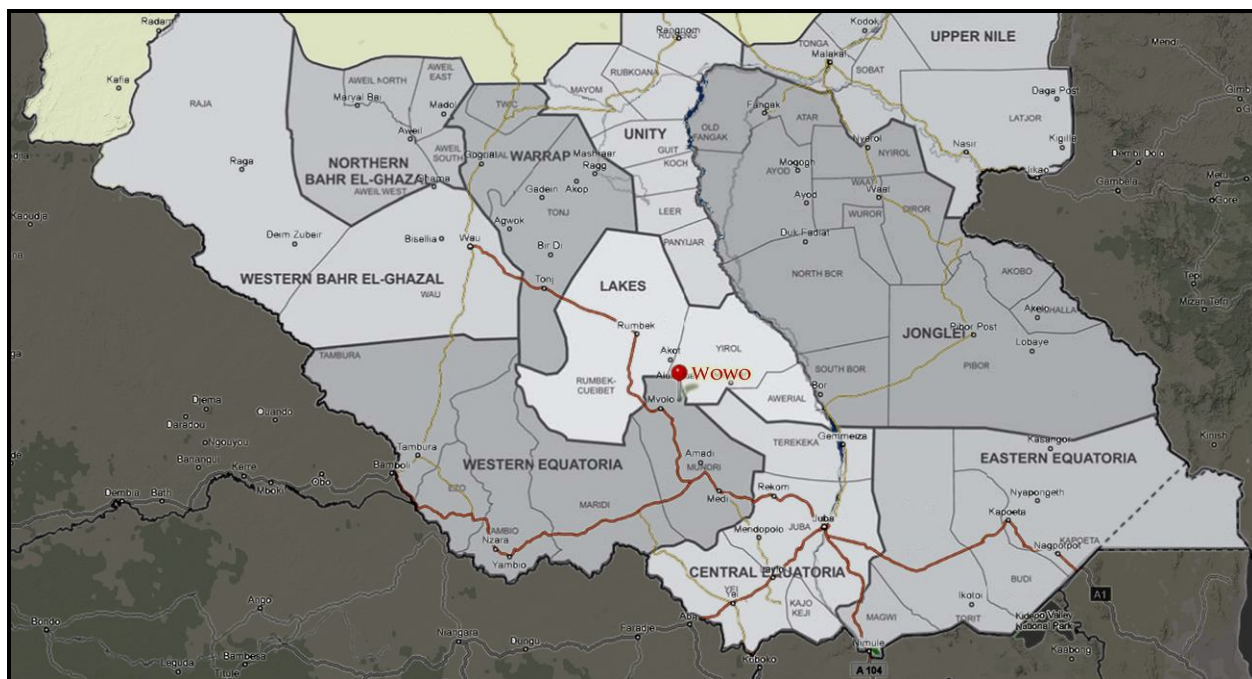

Stated Project Purpose:



Project funding allows Aid Sudan to facilitate the construction of a school and clinic and the drilling of a water well in the village of Wowo, Sudan. With a current population of almost 8,000, the community is in dire need. The school is currently housed in a church, the clinic is in a run-down mud hut, and there is only one water well for the surrounding area. Partly due to its prime location along a main road, this village has seen major growth, but that only increases the severity of the need. It will now soon be powerfully transformed, as will the community around it.

Project Update:

There is much rejoicing in Wowo as the people celebrate their new school and clinic! It is hard to give a more powerful, tangible gift to a community. They have received the buildings as a gift from God through Gulf Winds International.

Rains have further delayed the installation of the water well, as the road to Wowo remains impassable this time of year. However, the rainy season is winding down, and soon the drilling rig will be able to reach Wowo. The well will be a welcomed addition to the clinic and school that are powerfully transforming the community.

After Executive Director Peter Swann's trip to Wowo this past June, we have continued to hear reports from our implementing partner in the region. Another Aid Sudan team will be visiting Wowo in October, and will have more reports of the community's progress. There is no way to express how this project is bringing hope, vitality, health, and joy to the people of Wowo!
